

# A GUIDE TO TANKERING

Businesses are obliged to ensure waste is disposed of safely, with no danger to people or the environment. Follow the simple steps below to ensure your waste is dealt with securely, legally and sustainably.

Check **Bran Sands Permit** for approved EWC codes.

2

Make an enquiry via the **Waste Declaration Form** and submit to us along with a 1 litre representative sample. If an MSDS sheets exists for the hazardous waste, please include this with the form .

We will then test the sample and notify you if it has passed or failed our internal acceptance criteria. An explanation advisory note will be provided on what has failed and suggestions as to where you could take the waste to be processed will be provided.

If the sample passes, you will be given a unique waste stream code. We will then confirm the price, waste specification and booking requirements.

If you are happy to accept the offered price, request a booking using the unique code and full description at least 48 hours in advance of your preferred slot.

You will then be notified of your booking confirmation.
